# TILTED TOWERS

Private purchases have become more than just a staple of the Little Red Feather brand. In 2014, LRF purchased a minority interest in Midnight Storm, who went on to become a GI winner on turf, a multiple graded stakes winner on dirt, and was recently retired to stallion duties in Kentucky after earning nearly \$1.8M on the racetrack. In 2016, LRF purchased an interest in My Boy Tate, who has since reeled off five consecutive victories including back to back stakes wins in New York. Earlier in 2018, LRF purchased an interest in GIII winner, Fault. The 4yo Blame filly paid instant dividends when she captured the GII \$200,000 Buena Vista Stakes at Santa Anita on March 17. We believe we have just made another outstanding private purchase by adding unraced 2yo colt, TILTED TOWERS, to the LRF stable.

Tilted Towers was bred by John & Renee Liviakis, who are known as one of the most creative and successful breeders in the country. This classy looking 2yo colt is a half sister to LRF's Loving Moment, also owned and bred by the Liviakis'. Loving Moment just missed in her second career start at Santa Anita and looks like a stakes-type filly. Tilted Towers is by first crop sire, Atreides, out of the Not For Love mare, Rich Love.

By Medaglia D'Oro out of multiple GI winning mare, Dream Rush, Atreides was bred to be a champion. Atreides won his first three starts by a combined 25 lengths, earning Beyer figures of 105, 102, and 105 and thoroughbred sheet numbers of negative 2, negative 2, and negative 5! An unfortunately injury cut his career short but we're hopeful he will pass on his speed and athleticism to his offspring.

# FAMILY

Tilted Towers is by one of the best bred and fastest horses of our generation, Atreides. By one of the world's leading stallions, Medaglia D'Oro, and out of Breeders' Cup Champion and earner of over \$3.3M, Dream Rush, Stonestreet had massive expectations for this colt and he delivered. Atreides captured his maiden by over five lengths while earning a 105 Beyer. In his second start, he won an allowance race by 3 lengths earning a 102 Beyer. Then, in his stakes debut, he captured the Monarchos Stakes by over 17 lengths! An injury stopped Atreides career but he showed enough brilliance to become a sire immediately.

On the bottom, Loving Moment is out of Rich Love, by Not For Love, broodmare sire of one of North America's most best racehorses in recent memories, seven-time G1 winner and Kentucky Derby winner, California Chrome. In fact, Rich Love is bred identical to Love The Chase, the dam of California Chrome. Both mares are by Not For Love out of a Polish Numbers mare. Bred by the very astute John Liviakis, Loving Moment's pedigree is flush with fascinating bloodlines and is line bred 3X3 to Numbered Account, just like California Chrome's dam. One of the best 2YO fillies in the history of the breed, Numbered Account quickly established herself as an aspiring broodmare with her first foal, Grade 1 winner and leading sire, Private Account. She would go on to become one of Ogden Phipps' greatest mares and Numbered Account's fifth dam is none other than La Troienne, one of the greatest producers in American racing.

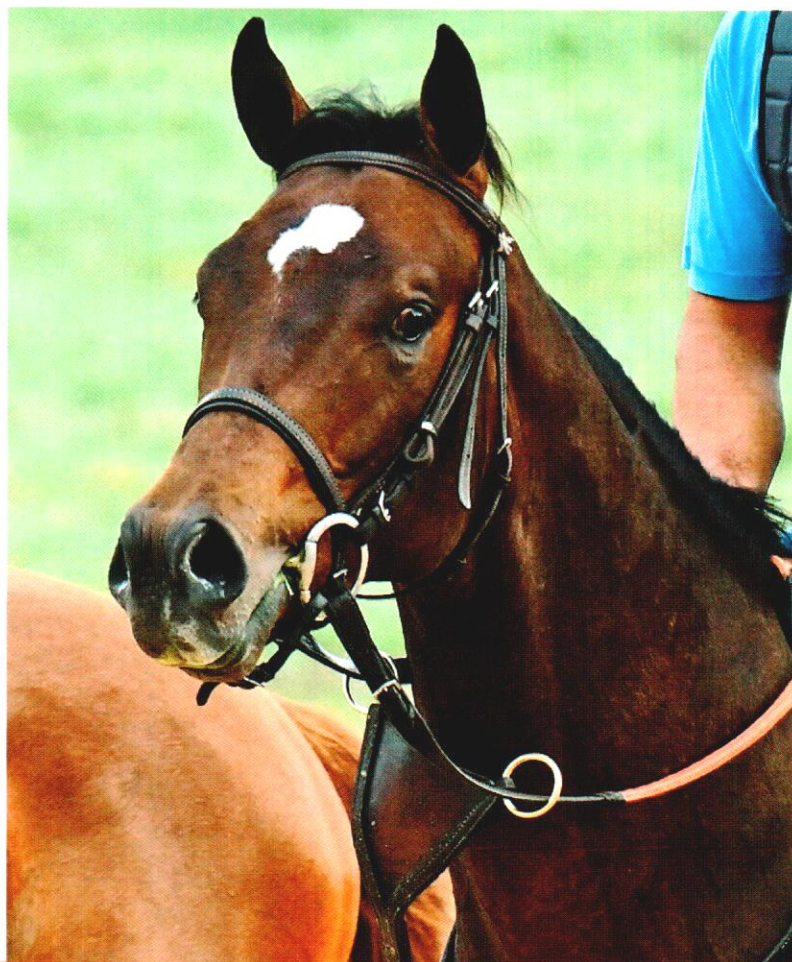




# WHY NOT?
